Course Description:

3. Use power self-talk on personal performance (tactic).
4. Generate verbal and non-verbal positive communication to influence others (strategy).
5. Eliminate negativity and negative self-talk (strategy).
6. Overcome fears of the unknown and meet new challenges.
7. Reduce stress and focus on achieving goals.
8. Recognize the winner within oneself.
9. Examine the pathways of successful people.
10. Connect the 7 secrets of success to teaching and CCSS.
11. Demonstrate a deep knowledge of the 7 steps to success and performance-based approaches to effective learning.
12. Apply a variety of strategies to bring and enhance the secrets of success to learning, improving learning, and the power of solving problems.

13. Implement the 7 secrets in reading, language arts, math, science, social studies, and many other subjects.
14. Explain effective 7 secrets techniques that can be used immediately.
15. Teach the 7 secrets for deep learning and retrieval as it relates to obtaining and maintaining excellence.
16. Identify the 7 secrets and how they work step by step.
17. Identify major benefits of using the 7 secrets.
18. Discuss problem solving through the 7 secrets.
19. Describe the 7 secrets can help ELD and Special Ed students.
20. Create appropriate materials to teach the 7 secrets
